



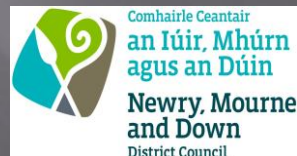

We look at safety in Forest School and go through the rules – 1 whistle – stop, 2 whistles – come back and 3rd rule – Have fun and learn



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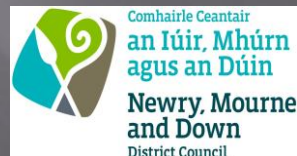
BOUNDARIES

begin with



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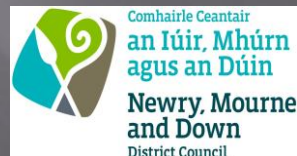
CHALLENGE – WHITTILING BUG HOUSES

We tie them together to make a bug hotel. Leave them some place and look at them in a weeks time to see if there any bugs



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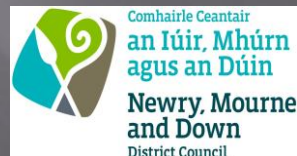
CHALLENGE – FIRE
